



Delta Waterfront Project *Creating the Hub for the Community by the Community*

August 2019

The Delta Community Improvement Committee, a volunteer sub committee of the Delta & Area Community Enhancement Committee working on behalf of the Township of Rideau Lakes, is in the process of gaining donations for the Delta Waterfront project. Many of you may have visited the open house on Sept 15, 2018 and chose Option 2 as the best design for the Delta Waterfront Park, and so we are now in the process of making it happen.

This project has been broken down into seven Phases to be completed over the next few years, but of course, it all depends on funding. Phase 1 includes *Survey, CRCA permits and approvals and landscaping* and is currently in progress. The Survey has been completed and now Riverview Design, the selected landscape design company, is creating the drawings and specifications for the shoreline stabilization, where work will commence this fall. In the 2019 budget, Council allocated funding for this phase of the project and so far, we have received \$5,100 in private funding towards Phase 2 that will include *Excavations, Rough Grade, Granular Pathways and Boardwalk and underground servicing for Lighting*. Each phase will thereafter bring us closer to completion.

Making the Delta Waterfront Park a reality requires all levels of contribution. Major gifts can be in the form of in-kind products and services or contributions over a three-year period, recognizing the phasing of the park development but no donation is too small. In addition to these contributions, the Committee is actively seeking government funding that can further leverage your contribution.

The Delta Waterfront Project is an investment in the creation of a community hub that builds an authentic '*sense of place*' with existing heritage and natural assets within a community that is committed to and passionate about its youth, families, seniors and guests from around the world.

Hamlet Vitality is one of the top items on the Strategic Plan for this term of Council and so we believe that this project, located right in the middle of the downtown area will do just that. We are already seeing restoration happening in our Jubilee Block and with new commercial enterprises on the main street, this development project will offer water access for people of all abilities and be a cultural asset for our community. Of course, being located alongside our Old Stone Mill National Historic Site doesn't hurt either.
